

### **November Meeting Notes**

- 30 New Members! 3 Withdraws
- Thank You from District Lodge 70 for your involvement in making the 7th Annual Robert Martinez Jr. Golf Invitational Fundraiser for Guide Dogs of America a success.
- Donation of \$500 to KANSEL's Support Banquet Team Trivia.
- Approved to send Teressa Peart to the Women's Leadership Program in February 2019.
- Approved to pay the Union Label yearly affiliation fee of \$100.
- Approved a letter to be mailed to notify all LL774 members of a 2019 dues increase of \$1.20 per month.
- Nominations and Elections for W-3's 2019 Leadership Classes

- Approved to send three (3) delegates to the Kansas State Council meeting in Topeka, KS.
- Approved to send Scott Gardner to News Writing for Communicators Class in January. (Class postponed to July 2019).
- District Lodge Business Representatives were able to restore hundreds of thousands of dollars to members from the Lump Sum and Cola pay-out error in October.
- District Lodge Business Representatives continue to review issues with the Lump Sum and COLA payouts to employees RISP accounts in October to ensure everyone is made whole.
- An agreement was made to extend Article 27.16 CBA language to all bargaining unit employees. "Volunteers who work

the Thanksgiving weekend and the two holiday weekends during the Christmas shutdown will be paid at two times their base hourly rate of pay. Additionally, employees who work the Christmas shutdown holidays will receive one day of vacation for every three days of work.
