Flags of Freedom is a grand display of 600 American flags hosted by United Way of the Plains and IAM & AW District Lodge #70. Participate by purchasing a dedication in honor or memory of a veteran in your life, visiting the flags, and attending the dedication ceremony.

## **PURCHASE A DEDICATION FOR \$30**

- Dedications in honor or memory of service member include the veteran's name, branch of service, rank and a short, personal tribute that will be published at unitedwayplains.org/freedom (updated every Tuesday and Friday).
- An acknowledgment email will be sent to inform the service member or contact of your choice of your gift.
- As a tribute to your veteran, a certificate with their name and your name will be posted to a flag, which you can visit to honor their service (pictured right).

Your \$30 donation will provide local veterans with 17 free rides on Wichita Transit through the Veterans Ride Free program, helping them access employment, doctor appointments and more.






## **VISIT THE FLAGS**
